Peggy Smith this day appeared in Court according to the condition of her recognizance entered
into for her appearance and was set to the bar in Custody of the Sheriff and charged with the felony
aforesaid, and thereupon a Mrs. M. appeared on behalf of the Commonwealth and on
the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth and for reasons appearing to the Court it is
ordered that the examination of the prisoner be adjourned till the next County Court.

It is remembered that William Carri who stands bound for Joseph Stephens an infant Widows on
behalf of the Commonwealth and Sarah Corbett her co-Defendant acknowledged themselves to be indebted
to William Cary Nicholas Ingram Somers or chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia and
his Successors in office for the time being in the sum of three hundred and thirty three dollars
and thirty four cents each, of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be
levied due to the former and Successors for the use of the Commonwealth received. Yet upon this
condition that if the said Joseph Stephens and Sarah Corbett shall appear before the Justices of the
County Court of Southampton at the Court house of said County on the third Monday in May next
by the said Carri of that day to give such evidence as they and each of them know or believe of the
Commonwealth against Peggy Smith who stands charged with murder and shall not appear
thence without leave of the Court then this Recognizance to be void.
