Ordered that William Bailey, Millicent Bells & Henry D. Immund or any two of them in conjunction with the persons appointed by the Court of Isle of Wight County let the repairs or rebuilding of Gooders bridge which they may think best, to the said amount of a hundred dollars, taking bond with approved Security for the due and faithful performance of the same, and when the same shall be completed that the said Commissioners or any three of them make a report thereof to the Court.

The order made at the last Court to summon Mills Butler to appear here this day to show cause why an attachment should not issue against him, and the same being returned, executed, &c. Ordered that an attachment be issued against the said Mills Butler for such his contempt shown to the Court.

Ordered that Daniel Butler and Nicholas Williams be summoned to the next Court, to show cause if any they can why there should not be a fine imposed upon them for failing to attend when summoned, according to Law upon a writ of ad. quod damus and for the purpose of making John Cricklows Mills draw across the said mill race.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the Court are Counsel

At a Called Court held for the County of Southampton the 25th day of April one thousand eight hundred and fifteen for the examination of Peggy Brutt who stands charged with murder

Peggy Brutt this day appeared in Court according to the condition of her recognizance entered into for her appearance and was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff and charged with the felony aforesaid, and thereupon a Mrs. M. appeared on behalf of the Commonwealth and on the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth and for recovery appearing to the Court it is ordered that the examination of the prisoner be adjourned till the next County Court.

As it remanded that William Carri who stands bound for Joseph Stephens an infant Widows on behalf of the Commonwealth and Sarah Corbett her co-Defendant acknowledged themselves to be indebted to William Cary Nicholas Eugene Sumner ex chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia and his Successors in office for the time being in the sum of three hundred and thirty three dollars and thirty four cents each, of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be secured due to the Sumner and Successors for the use of the Commonwealth's residence. Yet upon this condition that if the said Joseph Stephens and Sarah Corbett shall appear before the Justices of the County Court of Southampton at the Court house of said County on the third Monday in May next by New O. Look of that day to give such evidence as they and each of them know on behalf of the Commonwealth against Peggy Brutt who stands charged with murder and shall not appear hence without leave of the Court then this Recognizance to be void.
