Yet so be void upon the condition that if the Piggie Brett shall appear here personally at the next Superior Court to be holden in this County on the Seventh day of September next and shall not depart hence without the leave of the Court.

William Carr who stands bound for Joseph Rapperson Sarah Corbett and Elizabeth Myers personally came into Court and acknowledged themselves and each of them to be indebted to his excellency Wilson Cary Nicholas Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the term of three hundred and thirty three dollars and thirty four cents each of their lands and tenements, goods and chattels to be heirs and to the use of the Commonwealth to be rendered. Yet upon the condition that if Sarah Corbett, Elizabeth Myers and Joseph Rapperson do personally appear at the next Superior Court to be holden for this County on the Seventh day of September next then and there to give such testimony as they and each of them know or believe of the Commonwealth against Piggie Brett who stands charged with murder and shall not depart thence without leave of the Court then this recognizance to be void.

This Cause was this day docketed by the consent of the parties and the appointment of the Court and was heard upon the bill and the answer of the defendants and was argued by Counsel, whereupon the Court with adjudge over and decree that Richmonds Dillards, Ethelreda Barker, James Carl and others a bar or any other of them, do sell at public auction a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing fifty three acres which was allotted to the complainants and defendants in right of their deceased mother Polly Glover, in the division of the real Estate of which a certain Darden and Leiza, having first given at least two months previous notice by advertisements in sufficient parts of this said County, of the time and place of sale that the said Commissioners make the said sale on a credit of twelve months, except as to the sum of \$75 which by consent of the parties is to be paid in cash for the purpose of paying the costs of this suit that they take from the purchase four bonds with approved Security each for one fourth part of the purchase money except the said sum of \$75 to be paid in cash and assign one of the said bonds to the complainant Robert Glover and one of the said bonds to the complainant Julia Glover and one of the said bonds to the defendant John Glover as curator for the infant defendant John Glover and the remaining bond to the said Carl Dawson as curator for the infant defendant Henry Glover and make a proper filing and assign in this behalf to the Court in order to a final Decree.
