Ordered that Anne James Richardson Edwards, Susan Edwards and William Edwards or any three of them being first sworn before a magistrate for that purpose do appraise in current money the value of any and personal Estate of Mary Weston deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

The Last will and Testament of James Fowler deceased now possessed by the parties of Matthew Garman, Elizabeth Fowler and Nancy Fowler the intestate thereto and is ordered to be recorded on the motion of Tabitha Fowler the executrix therein named who made oath thereto and together with Joshua Corbett and Richard Edwards her Leuities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five thousand Dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted her for obtaining a probate thereof in due form Liberty is reserved for the executor named in the said will to gain in the probate when he shall think fit.

Ordered that Matthew Garman, William Edwards, William Fowler Jr. and Anne James or any three of them being first sworn before a magistrate for that purpose do appraise in current money the value of any and personal Estate of James Fowler deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.
