personal estate of Lewis Knight deceased and return the appraisement
to the Court.

On the motion of Abel Johnson who made oaths and together with
Benjamin Wilson, Isaac Beale his securities entered into an
acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars
conditioned at the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining
letters of administration on the estate of Lewis Johnson deceased
in due form.

On the motion of Thomas Browne who made oaths and together with
George Harley and Nicholas Bryant his securities entered into an
acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned
as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of
administration on the estate of William Neiley deceased in due form.

A list of inhabitants of the summer tax, the bounty and poor rate levy
being returned, was examined and approved of by this Court, sworn to
by Henry Harley, Deputy of Jacob Darby Sheriff which is ordered to be
entered of record.

Ordered that Lewis Morell, Dorey Bryant, Frederick Robertson and Isaac
Nick or any three of them being first sworn before a magistrate of this
County do appraise in current money the slaves property and personal estate
of William Neiley deceased and return the appraisement to the law.

Ordered that Joshua Fort, James Freyant and James Rochelle or any
two of them do examine State and Letters and account of Jacob
Darby Sheriff with this County, and that they make a report to the law.

Ordered that Jacob Darby retains in his hands twenty five dollars
it being the amount of the Sheriff's salary for the last year, out
of the contingent funds and account with this Court.

Ordered that the fine made at the last Court against Nicholas Williams
for non attendance when legally summoned, on a Writ of garnishee
against John Crichton Miller due, be received.

On the motion of Edwin Bef who made oaths and together with
Spratt Williams his security entered into an acknowledged a bond
in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs
certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the
estate of Mills Bef deceased in due form.
