

being fully heard by himself. The Court after hearing the testimony sworn in and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner is not guilty of the Larceny whereof he stands charged and therefore proclamation being made in this manner is: and nothing further appearing or being alleged against him it is ordered that he be discharged from his imprisonment.

That next a negro man stole the property of James Reese was sent to the Jail by the Sheriff into which custody he was therefore committed and charged with Larceny and the Court which was summoned for his examination not having met and therefore since if witnesses appeared on behalf of the Commonwealth to wit) John Barham being sworn and examined and Jeffrey and Phoenix, negro men the property of John Reese being charged and the prisoner being fully heard by himself. The Court after hearing the testimony sworn and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner is not guilty of the Larceny whereof he stands charged and therefore proclamation being made in this manner is: and nothing further appearing or being alleged against him it is ordered that he be forthwith discharged from his imprisonment.

Mills Butler Guarant to Richard Daisow, produced accounts of her said Manor Estate which account was examined and allowed by the Court sworn to by the guarant and ordered to be recorded -

On the motion of Wilkinson Capell to be exonerated from the payment of taxes on a tract of Land returned in the name of Job Barham's Estate for the year 1805 he having proved to the Satisfaction of the Court that the taxes thereon charged are not so due and in answer therefore it is ordered that he be exonerated therefore the Attorney for the Commonwealth being present.

The Jurors appointed by a former order of this Court to make a division of the Land whereof Kelly White's and assigns this day make their report in the words and figures following to wit - Appraisable to our order of the County of Southampton to us directed bearing date November 1814 We have gone over the Land of Kelly White deceased allured with the County Surveyor as by the map we were required and have run out one Survey of the same and make the division in the same in manner and form following to wit) In the first place we have laid off assignees and set apart to Kelly White's widow and heirs of the said Kelly White deceased one third part of the said Land for life in kind and have had regard to quality as well as quantity by proper metes and bounds to wit Beginning at a Keyhole in Abraham's Lane runs thence S 40. V 46 poles to Express in the Spring house Thence N 32. V. 17 Poles thence S 29. V. 30 poles to a large hydrop, thence N 2. V. 30 Poles backwater over then N 47. V. 44 Poles the ditch which was cut from the river being the dividing line of lots 281 running thence along that ditch, and then thence a straight line to a Laurel red oak a narrow corner made in the down Lane, thence along the but bounds to the first Station containing twenty Acres being her Proportionable part as done for Life -
