

Thence beginning at the ditch being a dividing line of John & White Lot No 1
 running thence N, E, S, 74 pole to a small pine a new corner made in Lot No 1
 near the fields call the dividing line between Lot No 1 & 2 a new black line a new
 corner made in Lot No 2 and 3. on the north corner in Jonathan Luter line thence
 along ditch out boundaries to a small red oak bush new corner in the same line
 and thence along the corner line to the first station being John & White Lot No 1
 containing 50 Acres Value at 2 dollars per acre amounting to 100 dollars being his
 proportionable part of the lands of the 2 red subject to a division at a future day
 of Mary White Dower which makes his full portion of the lands of his deceased
 father, after receiving four said Ducks Lot No 1 & 2 Thomas & White Lot No 3 the sum
 of \$1.50 cents each which make his full portion in the lands as appears
 Thence beginning at a small pine a new corner made in John & White Lot
 No 1 & 2 said Ducks Lot No 1 in right of his wife Nancy running thence N, E, S, 36
 pole to a large pine stand standing on the banks of black water River a new corner
 near the said Ducks Lot No 2 and Thomas & White Lot No 3 thence N, E, S, 16
 pole to a small red oak a new corner made in the Lot No 2 & 3 in Daniel Sumner
 former line thence along his line to Jonathan Luter line, and thence along ditch
 line to a Black Gum a new corner made in ditch our corner being a corner
 of Lot No 1 & 2 and thence along that dividing line of Lot No 1 & 2 N, E, S, 16 pole
 to the first station being Lot No 2 which Lot was drawn by said Ducks in
 right of his wife Nancy. Duck formerly Nancy White daughter and heir of
 Shelly White deceased containing 51 1/2 Acres Value at 3 dollars per acre
 making 154 1/2 dollars being his proportionable part of the said lands still
 subject to an equal division of the same Mary White Dower after her
 decease in right of his wife Nancy after paying to John & White Lot No 1 the
 sum of \$1.50 his full portion of the said lands in right of his wife Nancy equal
 to 100 from 154.50 leaves 54 1/2 dollars his part of the present division thence
 beginning at a large pine a new corner made in said Ducks and Thomas
 & White Lot No 2 and running thence N, E, S, 36 pole to a large pine standing on
 the side of the River and thence up the river the same corner thence to a
 large red corner of the same Lot formerly Daniel Sumner line thence N, E, S,
 16 pole to a large red oak a new corner made in the same Lot out
 line a corner of Lot No 2 and 3 thence along that dividing line of Lot No 2 & 3
 N, E, S, 14 1/2 pole to the first station being Lot No 3 which Lot was drawn by
 Thomas & White containing 51 1/2 Acres Value at 3 dollars per acre making 154 1/2
 his proportionable part of said lands after paying to John & White Lot No 1
 the sum of 1.50 which sum deducted from 154.50 leaves 153 his full portion
 of the said lands after standing and equal division in the same right of
 his mother Mary White at a future day. I was under our hand at this 16th

 made as above in the pole line and fields former and that this be proportionally

the parties appeared by a former order of this Court to make a division of the
 same Mary White deceased and heirs and heirs. This day made their report in the

 and heirs of Shelly White deceased for her one third part of all the lands
