 In the first place we proceed to state all the negroes belonging to the
 Estate namely Peter 300 dollars, James 300 dollars, Jacob 300 dollars
 Sam 300 dollars, Venice 300 dollars Maria 300 dollars, Henry 180 dollars
 Hans 175 dollars and Avery 75 dollars making up the whole valuation
 2375 dollars, these allotting are setting apart for wife in the first place
 to Mary White widow his relief of Kelly White deceased as her
 master for life one thus part of the valuation of the slaves which is
 771 dollars 53 cents are here apportioned to her the following negroes
 namely Jacob, Value at 300 dollars Maria 300 dollars and Hans 175
 dollars making 825 which is \$3.00 cents more than her proportion of
 slaves in the aforesaid slaves, but is as near as we can possibly
 make them of which sum of \$3.00 cents the said Mary White will pay
 to Thomas J. White lot of slaves in case to make up his proportion of the
 remaining two thirds of negroes aforesaid -

Also we have allotted said wife and apportioned to Jacob Duck our right
 of his wife Nancy Duck formerly formerly Nancy Whites his proportionable
 part of the remaining two thirds of the slaves which sum is \$27.83
 and set apart the following negroes to make that sum which left
 he draws namely, Peter Valued at 300 dollars and Venus at 300 dollars
 making up all 600 dollars which is \$27.83 cents more than his proportion
 in the remaining two thirds of the said slaves which sum of \$27.83
 Jacob Duck pays to Thomas J. White lot of slaves in case to make an
 equal proportion in the division of the remaining two thirds
 which sum of \$27.83 cents deducted from 600 dollars leaves \$27.83
 cents his full proportionable part of the said slaves in right of his
 wife Nancy. Also we have allotted apportioned and set apart to the
 said White infant child of Kelly White deceased his full proportionable
 part of the remaining two thirds of the slaves of the said deceased
 namely sum 300 dollars and Avery 180 dollars making 480 dollars
 which is \$27.83 cents more than his proportion in the remaining two
 thirds of the slaves aforesaid, which you may see by deducting 27.83
 from 480 it leaves \$27.83 his full proportionable part of the said slave
 after paying to Thomas J. White lot the sum of \$27.83 cents in case
 to make his full proportion in the remaining two thirds of slaves
 aforesaid - Also we have allotted and apportioned to Thomas White
 infant child of Kelly White deceased the following slaves to wit, Sam
 Valued at 300, and Avery 75 dollars making 375 dollars which is
 his proportionable part of the remaining two thirds of the slaves
 aforesaid, after receiving from Mary White widow his Relief of
 Kelly White deceased the sum of \$3.00 cents (as from Jacob Duck
 in right of his wife namely the sum of \$27.83 cents (as from
 Thomas J. White lot of 2 negroes the sum of \$27.83 cents (as from
 Sam and Avery 75 dollars makes \$27.83 cents which respectively
 the remaining two thirds of the slaves belonging to the estate of his deceased
