Ordered that Pharaoh Boykin, John L. Gray, Arthur Holliman and George
B. Holt or any three of them do let to the lowest bidder the repairing
or rebuilding of the upper Leacock bridge taking bond with approved security
from the bidder or undertaker for the due and faithful completion
of the same and that when the same shall be so completed, payable to
be so that the said Commissioners make a report to the Court

Ordered that Wheland Barnes, James Carr and Arthur Carr or any two of
them do examine take and certify and account of the administration
of the Estate of Isaac B. Hollands deceased and make report to the Court

Carr Barnes having produced to the Court a commission from the
Governor as chief magistrates of the Commonwealth of Virginia appointing
them Major in Battalion and 65th Regiment of Virginia Militia who
qualified themselves according to Law
