Jones who made oath and together with Littleberry Jones and John Williams his kinsmen entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs to be granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Rebecca Jones dec'd. do due form.

Ordered that Michael Ellis, Britton Williams, George Holt and Garrison J. Bell or any three of them being first sworn before a Magistrate of this County do appraise in current money the Real and any the personal estate of Rebecca Jones deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

On the motion of Nancy Barnett who made oath and together with Amos Kephaw and James Barnett her kinsmen entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs to be granted her for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Elias Barnett deceased in due form.

Ordered that John Thomas, Henry Thomas, Joseph Zeyner and John Good or any three of them being first sworn before a Magistrate of this County do appraise in current money the Real and any the personal estate of Elias Barnett deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

Nancy Barnett is by the Court appointed Guardian to Richard Barnett orphan of Elias Barnett deceased who together with Amos Kephaw and James Barnett her kinsmen entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars with a condition according to law.

An inventory and appraisement of the estate of Josiah Nick's deceased being returned is ordered to be entered of record.
