On the motion of Henry Porter, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages on one hundred and fifty five acres of land part of a tract of two hundred and twenty five Acres which was returned in the name of Isaac Porter for the years 1793 and 1795 The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present

On the motion of Peter Pope, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages on one hundred and fifty Acres of land which was returned in the name of Andrew Pope for the year 1789 and in the name of Sarah Pope for the year 1789 The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present

Colonel's Rochelle personally appeared in open Court and produced thereto a Commission under the hand and Seal of the Patriarch of the Governor or chief magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia a Commission appointing him high by a company of Militia in the 65th Regiment N^o 2^d Militia and first Battalion of the 1st Whitehead to be Lieutenant and Samuel Maggett to be Ensign in said Company Whereupon the said Rochelle Whitehead and Maggett took the Oath of office prescribed by Law which is ordered to be entered of Record
