

On the motion of John H. Bonds, It is ordered that he be separated from the payment of the taxes and damages on fifty Acres of Land which was returned in the name of Hannah Francis for the years 1789 and 1795 The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present.

On the motion of Joseph M. Ballance, David Bowser and John Lawrence by Joseph Smith their Attorney to be separated from the payment of taxes and damages on — Acres of Land which was returned in the name of John Lawrence for the new payment thereof for the years 1788, 1790, 1793, 1797 and 1798 which motion was opposed by James Boppant Attorney for the Commonwealth. The Court after hearing the testimony assessed and all the circumstances of the case and they being divided in opinion It is ordered that the motion be overruled and that the Commonwealth recover her cost by her in this behalf expended.

Drury Bryant was brought into Court by the Sheriff of this County when ordered by the Court to suppress a riot on the Court House Ground, for a breach of the Peace, and the Court after hearing the circumstances of this case are of opinion that the said Drury Bryant find Security for his good behaviour for the space of twelve calendar months from this day, himself in the sum of one hundred dollars and two Licentia in the sum of fifty dollars each, and in default thereof that he be committed to Jail. Whereupon the said Drury Bryant with Benjamin Whitfield and James Remond his Licentia here in Court solemnly acknowledged themselves to be indebted to his excellency Wilson Cary Nicholas Esquire Governor or Chief Magistrate of this Commonwealth the said Drury Bryant in the sum of one hundred dollars and the said Benjamin Whitfield and James Remond in the sum of fifty dollars each of their respective lands and Tenements, goods and chattels to be levied, and to our said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth hereinafter. Yet upon this condition that the said Drury Bryant shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour to and all the Citizens of this Commonwealth for the term of Twelve Months as aforesaid then this recognizance to be Void.

Daniel Mosforn and Eliza Whitfield was brought into Court by the Sheriff of this County by the direction of the Court, for a breach of the Peace, the Court after hearing the circumstances of the case It is ordered that the said Mosforn and Whitfield find security for their good behaviour for the space of twelve calendar months from this day the said Mosforn in the sum of one hundred dollars and two Licentia in the sum of fifty dollars each and the said Whitfield in the sum of fifty dollars and two Licentia in the sum of twenty five dollars each and in default thereof that they be committed to Jail. Licentia here in Court solemnly acknowledged themselves to be indebted to his excellency Wilson Cary Nicholas Esq. Governor or Chief Magistrate of this Commonwealth the said Whitfield in the sum of fifty dollars and the said Arthur W. Bond and John Russell his Licentia in the sum of twenty five dollars each of their respective lands and Tenements goods and chattels to be levied, and to our said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth.
