On the motion of Abraham Law, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of taxes and damages on forty nine acres of land which was returned in the name of Abraham Law. It is ordered that he cannot be exonerated for the years 1807 and 1808 (The attorney for the Commonwealth being present)
