

On the motion of John Ely, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages on twenty five acres of Land which was returned in the name of said Ely for the year 1806 (The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present)

On the motion of Lawson Boushamp, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages on thirty two Acres of Land which was returned in the name of Mary Weston for the year 1805 (The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present)

On the motion of John Corbett, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages on fifty acres of Land which was returned in the name of Nelson Bass, for the years 1795, 1796 and 1801 and on a tract containing one hundred and fifty Acres of Land which was returned in the name of Thomas Burns for the years 1797, 1798, 1799, 1800, 1801, 1802 and 1803 and on twenty five Acres of Land which was returned in the name of James Jeffrey for the year 1799 and on fifty acres of Land which was returned in the name of Edward Drake for the year 1805 and 1806 and on one hundred and fifteen acres of Land which was returned in the name of Elizabeth Williams for the years 1800, 1805 and 1806 and also on fifty one and a half Acres of Land a portion of one hundred and fifteen Acres which was returned in the name of John Williams for the years 1805 and 1806 (The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present)

On the motion of William Butler, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages on eighty eight Acres of Land which was returned in the name of Amos Butler for the year 1795 and on eighty eight Acres of Land which was returned in the name of Jonathan Butler for the years 1799 and on eighty eight Acres of Land which was returned in the name of William and David Butler for the years for 1805 and 1806 (The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present)

On the motion of Joshua Boyer, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages on Sixty two Acres of Land which was returned in the name of Joshua Boyer for the year 1806 (The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present)

On the motion of John Smith, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages on twenty three and three fourths of an acre of Land being a portion of a tract of two hundred and ten Acres of which was returned in the name of John Dill for the year 1796 (The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present)
