 precipitaries in Precinct No 80 for all the lands from the County line between  
 Blackwater and Leacock to French Branch down Black Creek black water.  
 John Clayton Jr and Joseph Nick are appointed precipitaries in Precinct No 81 which  
 includes all the lands from the County line to Blackwater road and down the  
 road to round hill Swamp down the same to the beginning. Lucy D. Brown  
 and Willie L. Dake are appointed precipitaries in Precinct No 82 which includes  
 all the lands from Blackwater road up road to the County line and thence to  
 black water and down black water to the said road. John Gray and  
 Richard B. Hills are appointed precipitaries in Precinct No 83 which contains  
 all the lands between Leacock and Round Hill the County line.  
 John H. Rose and John Dugay are appointed precipitaries in Precinct No 84  
 which includes all the lands between Round Hill and Black creek the aforementioned  
 and the County line. Daniel Butt and Charles Limmer are appointed  
 precipitaries in Precinct No 85 which includes all the lands between the Spaword  
 Notch River and the County line about Mr. R. Nick and Virginia Hill are  
 appointed precipitaries in Precinct No 86 which includes all the lands from the  
 County parish line thence to the head of Black Creek and to the Spaword and  
 down this swamp to Notch River and down the river to the former parish line.  
 Samuel E. Bagshaw and Simon Corpau are appointed precipitaries in Precinct No 87  
 which includes all the lands lying between Leacock, Blackwater and their materials.  
 John Hobelle and Clement Hobelle are appointed precipitaries in Precinct  
 No 88. Beginning at the mouth of Duck Swamp up that to home road along  
 home road to the Cope's swamp, down that to Notch River up to the beginning.  
 And it is ordered that the said Precipitaries do their said precipitating performances in  
 their respective precincts between the 1<sup>st</sup> day of February and the last day of March  
 next; and that they take and return to the Clerk, so soon as he shall  
 receive a copy of the persons present at the same and that land in their precincts  
 they shall fail to precipitate, and the particular reasons of such failure.

On the motion of Richard Coll, It is ordered that he be compensated from the  
 payment of the taxe and charges on one hundred acres of land which was  
 returned in the name of William Lane for the years 1795 and 1797 / His  
 attorney for the Commonwealth being present.

On the motion of Dr. Drake It is ordered that he be compensated from the  
 payment of less than damages on twenty five acres of land which was returned  
 in the name of Anna Drake for the year 1804 / His attorney for the  
 Commonwealth being present.

James Morris late of this and is appearing to the Court to say that  
 he has been continually absent for at least two years past without having  
 been home from his last time. Therefore on the motion of James Morris who  
 made his will together with James Furey his County interests into one  
 acknowledged as bonds on the sum of one thousand dollars bond to him  
 the sum amount calculated is granted him for obtaining Letters of Administration  
 on the Estate of James Morris and in due time.
