line and Cypress swamps. James Clayton and Micajah Griffin are appointed preceptors in Precinct No. 50. For all the lands from the former parish line between black water and Lacock to Grand branch and black creek and black water. John Clayton & and Joseph Back are appointed preceptors in Precinct No. 51. which includes all the lands from the de parish line to black water road and from the road to round hill swamp down the same to the beginning. Henry D. Brown and William L. Dicks are appointed preceptors in Precinct No. 52 which includes all the lands from blackwater road up south to the county line and thence to black water and down black water to the said road. John C. Gray and Richard B. Kille are appointed preceptors in Precinct No. 53. which contains all the lands between Lacock and Round hill and the county line. John H. Bond and John Dugger are appointed preceptors in Precinct No. 54 which includes all the lands between Round hill and black creek and blackwater road and the county line. Daniel Smith and Charles Simmons are appointed preceptors in Precinct No. 55 which includes all the lands between the stream of Nettoway River and the county line. Samuel H. Dicks and William Hill are appointed preceptors in Precinct No. 56 which includes all the lands from the former parish line, thence to the head of black creek and to the stream of Nettoway River and down the same to the former parish line. Samuel H. Boykin and James Boykin are appointed preceptors in Precinct No. 57 which includes all the lands lying between Lacock, black water and black water road. John Rochelle and Clement Rochelle are appointed preceptors in Precinct No. 58. Beginning at the mouth of Duck Swamp up that to horse road along horse road to the Cypress swamp and thence to Nettoway River up that to the beginning. And it is ordered that the said preceptors do see such precepting performed in their respective precincts, between the 15. day of February and the last day of March next; and that they take and return to the Court, by way of return land they shall precept to the persons present at the same and that lands in their precincts they shall fail to precept, and the particular reasons of such failure.

On the motion of Nathaniel Cobb. It is ordered that he be reimbursed from the payment to the taxes and damages on one hundred acres of land which was returned in the name of Anthony Lane for the years 1796 and 1797. His attorney for the same being present.

On the motion of Enos. It is ordered that he be reimbursed from the payment of taxes and damages on one hundred acres of land which was returned in the name of Enos for the year 1804. His attorney for the same being present.

James Beane late of Ohio. came & appearing to the Court & stating that he has been continuously absent for at least seven years, and neither he nor his heirs have been in that time. Therefore on the motion of Lewis Marshall who was with me together with Samuel Turner the County clerk into and acknowledged as being his personal or one thousand dollars bond to the said Lewis Marshall late of Ohio is granted, where for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of James Beane and his heirs.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock.
