On the motion of John Davis, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages due on Fifty Acres of land returned in the name of Davis Davis for the years 1793 & 1794 (The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present)

On the motion of Samuel Collett, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages due on Fifty Acres of land returned in the name of Collett for the years 1813, 1814 and 1815 (The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present)

On the motion of William Bell, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages due on one hundred and two Acres of land returned in the name of Elizabeth Moore for the year 1816 (The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present)
