Ordered that John Clayton, James Bond, Thomas Powell and Nige B Bond or any three of them being first sworn before a magistrate of this county appraise in current money the lands of any and personal estate of Lucy Mellons and and return the appraisement to the Court —

✓ On the motion of John Rockwell, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages on one hundred acres of land which is returned in the name of Edmund Spencer's Estate for the year 1790 (The attorney for the Commonwealth being present) —

✓ On the motion of Benjamin Parker, It is ordered that Samuel Blank James Mellons and Lucy Rockwell or any two of them do receipt and examine State and settle in account of the same disbursements on the estate of Frederick Parker deceased and make & report thereof to the Court —
