On the return of Henry Briggs administrator of Samuel Colwell and Plate Childs of this county out of any Collected money and his hands due the County upon the settlement of the said Samuel Colwell's collection of the County duty, for unto James Rochelle one hundred dollars for services performed under the revenue laws, and accounted with the Court

On the motion of Benjamin Dale, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages on all the lands which he returned under the names of James and William Higgins, and Abraham Higgins for the year precedent herein. (The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present)

Ordered that the view made at July Court last appointing John & Henry and Richard B. Hills procepiores in Precinct No 33 be reviewed and that John Bailey and Peter Botcher be appointed to view all the lands procepiores in said Precinct No 33 And it is ordered that the said procepiores do see such procepiores performed in their said Precinct between the 15th day of February and the 1st day of March next that they take and return to the Court, at every session here they shall so procepiores, of the persons present at the same and what lands in their precinct they shall fail to procepiores, and the particular reason of such failure

Ordered that the view made at July Court last appointing James & John Boyham and James Boyham to see all the lands procepiores in Precinct No 57 be so reviewed that John Boyham be appointed a procepiores in the said precinct No 57 in the name of James Boyham (who is deceased) And it is ordered that the said procepiores do see such procepiores performed in their said Precinct between the 15th day of February and the 1st day of March next, that they take and return to the Court, at every session here they shall so procepiores, of the persons present at the same, and what lands in their precinct they shall fail to procepiores and the particular reason of such failure

On the return of Robert Rich, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages on Three hundred and Sixty three acres of land which was returned in the name of Benjamin Drow for the year 1805 The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present

Ordered that the Master Commissioners of this county do examine the accounts and file an account current of the administration on the Estate of Francis Clements deceased And make a report thereof to the Court

On the return of Robert Rich, It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damages on Two hundred and forty acres of land which was returned in the name of Arthur Green for the years 1795 and 1796 The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present
