About George Bailey Plaintiff Hale Lammell Bent Testifies

- on the motion of Justice Darden It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damage on the hundred and fifty acres of land which was returned in the name of said Darden for the years 1772, 1801, 1802, 1803 and 1805 (The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present)

Henry Bailey this day produced to the Court a commission under the hand and seal of the state of his excellency the Governor or chief magistrate of this Commonwealth appointing him Collector of this County. Whereupon the said Bailey together with John Evans and Henry Thomas his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five Thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs whereupon he took the oath of fidelity the rest to support the Constitution of the United States and the oaths of office

Henry Bailey this day produced to the Court a bond in favor under the hand of his excellency the Governor or chief magistrate of this Commonwealth and seal thereof appointing him Collector of this County who entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five Thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs whereupon he took the oath of fidelity the oaths to support the Constitution of the United States and the oaths of office

- On the motion of Justice Rosey. It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damage on eight hundred and fifty four acres of land which was returned in the name of William M. Baker for the year 1790 also on Town Hundred one hundred three and one half of an acre of land returned in the years 1805 and 1806 (The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present)

Henry Bailey this day produced to the Court a certificate of his having qualified to a commission under the hand and seal of this State, of his excellency the Governor or chief magistrate of this Commonwealth appointing him Captain of a Company of Militia in the 45th Regiment of Virginia Militia which is deemed to be return of Record

- On the motion of James Johnson (of the of 400ff) It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damage on all the land returned in the name of Richard Morell from the year 1787 to the year 1807 inclusive (The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present)

- On the motion of Matthew Bryant (It is ordered that he be exonerated from the payment of the taxes and damage on one hundred acres of land which was returned in the name of William Murst for the years 1795, 1797, 1798 and 1806 (The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present)
