so equally as partition the tract of land which belongs to the late James Pendleton formerly
John Butto by the seats of his brother Benjamin Butto lying in this County and
containing two hundred and fourteen acres, are set as parts by justly divided and bound
one part and thence to the defendant Robert Richardson alias Mary his wife on eight of acres
and Mary and that they set off first the remaining equal part thereof to the Complainant
Pleasant Remond alias John & his wife Mary & his said wife to be apprised and employe
by her master the Complainant Daniel Robert alias to the age of twenty five years so
many as shall by make a report of their actions and bearing in the behalf to the Court
in order to a final Decree.

Ordered that Benjamin Clegg, George Rivers, Wilson G. Bell and John Davis or any two
of them or anyone else or others in account of the administration on the Estate of
James Drury deceased, are make report thereof to the Court.
