Ordered that David Boykin, Joshua Moulle, Elias Lummard and Samuel L. Boykin or any three of them being first sworn before a Magistrate to appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal Estate of Elizabeth Hart deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

William T. Smith this day produced to the Court a certificate of his being qualified to a Commissioner under the Seal and Seal of the State of Virginia the Governor or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth appointing him trustee in the forty fifth Regiment of Virginia militia, which is ordered to be recorded.

The Last Will and Testament of Alfred Howell deceased was proved by the oath of John Crocker, Joseph Mills Faircloth and Richard B. Day the Trustees thereunto named who made oath thereto together with the signature of Elizabeth Howell the executrix therein named who made oath thereto disengaging with John Barnes, Peter Barnes and John T. Blodow her securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty Twenty five Pounds and dollars conditioned as the Law directs certificate is granted to the said Elizabeth for obtaining a probate thereof in due form.

Ordered that Samuel Blunt, Nathaniel Bush, Thomas Vaughan Jr. and Thomas Vaughan Sr. or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice to appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal Estate of Alfred Howell deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

Ordered that Lucy Darnum be exempted in future from the payment of taxes laid down on her negroes, Hayah, Patience and Peter they being aged and infirm.
