On the motion of Miles Glass who moved with me together with John Hale and James
 Hale his Sonneth entered into our acknowledgement of bonds in the County of Gaffney hundred
 before Justice, as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining Letters of
 administration on the estate of Samuel Hale deceased in due form —

Ordered that William Davis, John Bishop Jr. Joseph Nick and John Bishop Esq. or any three
 of them being Just Sworn before a magistrate sufficient money the sum of
 my and joint Estate of Samuel Hale deceased has returns the appraisement to the Court

The Justices appointed by a former order of the Court to make a division of the lands and
 slaves whereof Benjamin Bennett well known and reported the day before their report
 in the words and figures following to Met "Agreeable to the above decree on the
 undesignated boundaries mentioned and divided the lands of Benjamin Bennett deceased
 also made sale of the negroes six males and equal division thereof between the above
 named legatees — John Thomas, James Smith, Jordan Bennett, his wife and
 January 29th 1814 — Wherefore It is desired and ordered that the division
 made as aforesaid be held firm, stable and binding between the parties and that
 the costs be proportionably borne between them —

The Justices appointed at June last to make Sale of the land and slaves whereof
 Joel Cahan deceased and his wife and make a division of the same, this day make
 their report in the words and figures following to Met "Agreeable to the within decree
 to be directed we have made Sale of the lands therein mentioned for the sum of
 £395.26 and conveyed the same in fee simple to James Burkhardt who became the
 purchaser, also have made Sale of the said slaves therein mentioned for the sum of
 £625.51 and have taken bonds of the said deceased master Mr. Hale paid to all the
 parties their Justes except Charles Burkhardt given under our hands the 18th October
 1815 — Benjamin Wahlen, Robert Nicholson, Abraham Nicholson, his son
 Wmson It is desired and ordered that the division made as aforesaid be held firm
 stable and binding between the parties and that the costs be proportionably borne
 between them —
