Ordered that the owners of the four, hind out Mason and Henry Whitfeta four children, according to law.

Ordered that the account of Joshua Corbett honestly, against the Commonwealth amounting to two dollars and fifty two cents be satisfied to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination and payment.

Ordered that James Jones, William Dwyer and James Turner or any two of them View the road which was turned by Joshua Corbett, and make a report to the Court, whether the same be in repair according to law.

Ordered that George Bailey be exempted in future from the payment of the taxes and fees on his negro manumission cases: This being agreed and affirmed.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the Court in house.
