Ordered that the Sheriff of the County unto whose hands administration on the estate of John P. Westbrook deceased hath been committed pay to Edward Ross administrator of John Ross deceased the amount of a judgment obtained by said Ross against the said Westbrook —

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County unto whose hands the administration on the estate of John P. Westbrook deceased hath been committed pay to Joshua Fort Thirtysix dollars the amount of his account —

Ordered that the owners of the poor, bind out Mason and Henry Whitfield poor children, according to law —

Ordered that the account of Joshua Barbitt deceased, against the Commonwealth amounting to two dollars and fifty two cents be certified to the Auditor of public accounts for his examination and payment —

Ordered that James Jones, William Jones and James Turner or any two of them have the rent which was turned by Joshua Barbitt, and make a report to the Court, whether the same be in repair according to law about George Bruley Present James Jones — Clerk Justice

Ordered that George Bruley be exempted in future from the payment of the taxes and leases on his negro woman slaves the being aged and infirm —

A Statement of the proceeding of the Sheriff relative to the delinquent lands in this County, was this day returned examined and approved by the Court sworn to by John Rice Deputy of Jacob Darden Sheriff and certified to be certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination —

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the Court in session —
