part, was acknowledged by the said Joseph H. Wall and wife a Certificate of the Clerk of the Court
and Nathaniel Lane Magistrate of the said County of Brunswick testifying the acknowledgment
of the said John Maria Wall in pursuance of an Act of Assembly in such Cases made and
provided and ordered to be recorded.

Benjamin Buffum is by the Court appointed a guardian of the person of the County for the Parish
of Northway, for the ensuing year, whereupon the said Buffum together with Levi Jones and
Levi Jones brother his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One Thousand
dollars with conditions according to law, and the said Buffum took the oath of fidelity to the
Constitution, the oath of office and the oath to support the Constitution of the United States.

The last will and Testament of William Atkinson deceased was proved by the oath of James
Jones and Samuel Leble two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the
motion of James Atkinson the executor thereof named whereupon the Court together
with the Plaintiff said John Jones his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the
penalty of Twenty Thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs a Certificate is granted
her for obtaining a probate thereof in due form.

Ordered that Isaac Brown, John Landford, William Jones and John Leble if any of them
being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace appear in Court naming the
Name of any and personal Estate of William Atkinson deceased and return the appearance
to the Court.
