

Let at a large white oak & corner of John's stone line, see now a new corner
 of Lott No 2 and 3 running thence S. 27. W. 103 Poles to a dead black oak, and a pine
 shaft outside of the oak, thence S. 67. W. 116 Poles to a dead black oak, and a
 corner made out Lott No 3 and 5 being Lott No 4 of John's Williams and Lucy Williams
 thence and North 280 Poles to a red oak & corner of Richard Rich's Corn
 fields being a corner of Zephiah Williams and Elias Williams Lott No 3 and 4
 thence N. 86. E. 262 Poles to a dead black oak, and a corner of Richard Rich's
 thence N. 5. West 28 Poles to a dead pine blown down on the side of Joseph Williams
 old field, thence N. 67. E. 98 Poles to a pine & new corner made on Lott No 2 and
 three thence N. 8. E. 203 Poles to the first Station containing 160 Acres Valued at 2
 dollars for acre making 320 dollars which Lott being 1/3 of the said lands after
 Zephiah Williams, which is her proportionable part of the said lands after
 paying to Lott No 1 the sum of \$1.25 which sum deducted from 320 dollars leaves
 \$188.95 her full Proportion of the said lands. Thence Beginning at a small
 black oak & new corner made on Zephiah Williams and Lucy Williams Lott
 No 3 and 5 running thence N. 67. West 110 Poles to a black oak & corner of Samuel
 Williams and John Williams, thence S. 71. West 100 Poles to a red oak & Station on
 the line, thence S. 80. N. 64 Poles, thence S. 37. N. 86 Poles to the lower corner of
 Samuel Williams new ground, thence S. 46. West 14 Poles to a new corner made
 on Elias Williams and Lucy Williams Lott No 4 and 5 thence along Lott No 4 and
 5 the dividing line thence S. 46 Poles to a new corner in field corner of Lott No 3, 4
 and 5 and then along the dividing line of Lott No 3 and 5 to the first Station
 being Lott No 5, which Lott was divided by Lucy Williams containing 160
 Acres Valued at 2 \$ for acre making 320 dollars being her proportionable part
 of the said lands after paying to Lott No 1 the sum of \$1.25 which sum
 deducted from 320 dollars leaves \$188.95 her full Proportion. Thence Beginning
 at a corner post on the field & corner of Lott No 3, 4 and 5 running thence along
 the dividing line between Elias Williams and Lucy Williams 246 Poles to new
 corner made on John Lott near Samuel Williams new ground, thence S. 44
 West 30 Poles to a red oak & corner of Richard Rich, thence S. 44. V. 160 Poles to a
 maple & corner of Richard Rich, thence S. 67. V. 60 Poles to a pine corner of
 Richard Rich, thence S. 41. V. 96 Poles thence S. 69. V. 42 Poles to a new corner of
 Rich on his field, thence N. 38. V. 36 Poles, thence N. 41. V. 24 Poles to a red oak &
 new corner made on Elias Williams and Zephiah Williams Lott No 3 and 4
 and thence along the dividing line to the 1st Station, being Lott No 4, which
 Lott was divided by Elias Williams containing 160 Acres Valued at 2 \$ for
 acre making 320 dollars being her proportionable part of the said lands after
 paying to Lott No 1 the sum of \$1.25 which sum deducted from 320 dollars
 leaves \$188.95 her full proportion. — Thence Beginning at a corner on
 William Williams line running thence N. 15. N. 109 Poles, thence S. 80. N. 920
 Poles to a corner and Lott line, thence S. 69. N. 58 Poles to a red oak corner of Samuel
 Williams and Thomas Jones, thence S. 53. V. 44 Poles thence S. 73. V. 130
 Poles to a corner of John's bottom, thence N. 67. E. 98 Poles thence S. 86. E. 203
 Poles to a new corner of bottom, thence S. 33. 334 Poles, thence S. 67. V. 56 Poles
 intersection of the two branches, thence N. 82. E. 4. Poles to the first Station, being Lott
 No 6 on the River, most tract containing 160 Acres Valued at 2 \$ for acre making
