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Nicholson, also was argued by himself and the defendants Remond, John Remond, James Remond, Isaac Remond, Mary Ann and his wife, Charles Remond, Benjamin Remond, Henry Remond - - - - - These names are numbers are unknown, children of Rowell Remond deceased and - - - - - whose names are numbers are unknown children of

Williamson and Elizabeth Williamson deceased who are out of this community are against whom the complainants offer to have process in the name of the law against about defendants. Still feeling, as before, are answer, the bill of the complainants is taken as confessed, against them and the Court now dealing only upon the matter of the said bill relating to the land devised by the last will and testament of Samuel Remond deceased by whom through the said deceased the said Sally Remond (deceased) and the said Samuel Remond (deceased) were the said land. After a jury order and decree that Thomas Vaughan and Samuel Black, John Nicholas, Lawrence Cook, Benjamin Mount Snow and Peter Blair being trustees of the same, by the lawyers of the complainants, as to the above land, situate lying and being in the said county, devised to the said Sally Remond as above and which before by her death in the lifetime of the said Samuel Remond, into eight equal parts, being partitioned regard to the quality of the said land, and allot one of the said parts to the complainants, Nicholas Remond and Mary Dices, another of the said parts to the complainants, Sarah Briggs, John S. Nicholson and Polly S. Nicholson, another of the said parts to the complainants, David Maynard and Isaac Hughes, and the defendants Remond (Maynard), John Maynard, James Maynard and Mary Ann Maynard, another of the said parts to the complainants Rowell Nicholson, John Mount, and Mary Briggs and the defendant John Nicholson, another of the said parts to the defendants Charles Remond, Benjamin Remond and Henry Remond, another of the said parts to - - - - - These names are numbers are unknown to the Court. William of Rowell Remond deceased, another of the said parts is - - - - - whose names are numbers are unknown to the Court. Elizabeth Williamson deceased and the remaining eighth part to the complainant, Elizabeth Remond, and which is returned to the parties, without to the said Court respectively, presenting to the Court, for any further order which may be deemed proper for a division or distribution among themselves. It is also ordered that process of law, returnable to the first March Term of this Court, commencing the defendant William Remond, executor of Elizabeth Remond deceased to appear here and answer the bill filed in this Court. It is further ordered that the above said complainants, or some of them as act, make a report of their doings and doing in this behalf to the Court on or prior to other process, or to a final decree to be held upon so much of the matter of the said bill, as is embraced by the Decree -
