The Court was this day docketed by consent of the parties and report of the Court and was heard upon the bill and the answer of the defendants and was argued by counsel whereupon the Court doth order, adjudge and decree that William Francis, Richard Blunt, and John Spencer or any two of them do sell at public auction on or before of Twelve months, Six, Six, and Six, the negro in the bill mentioned, which was before allotted to Joseph Powell and Ephra Powell, now deceased, as a dower of the House of John Powell deceased, giving at least two weeks previous public notice of the time and place of Sale that the said Commissioners or Two of them as aforesaid, require a bond, or bonds, with approved Surety, from the purchaser or purchasers payable to themselves and until the process of the said Sale equally between the complainant Michael Warren in right of his wife Sarah the complainant Bartholomew Barnes, the complainant Sally Francis the complainant Ephra Powell and the defendants John Powell, James Powell and George Powell taking care to pay over the proportion of the said James Powell to James Chesnut his Guardian and the proportion of the said George Powell to Usha Akers his Guardian. It is further ordered that the said James Francis or Two of them as aforesaid make a report of their sales and savings in the behalf to the Court in order to a final Decree.

James Wolfson appeared in Court according to the direction of his recognizance to answer the complainant of Sally Wolfson against him for as books of the Court and the said Sally Wolfson being solemnly called but came not therefore he is considered by the Court and accordingly decreed that the said Sally Wolfson be forever from further prosecution in this case.
