In Chancery

The cause was this day argued by counsel of the parties and Report of the Court was  
carried over to be heard on the last ensuing, equitable and arguments of Counsel whereupon and upon  
due consideration thereof has the Court with assent given and decree that John Fitch  
James B. Melchoir and Lawrence Cook and Richard Blunt or any two of them do write to  
the Plaintiff now belonging to the estate of Nathaniel Williams the sum amounting such  
as are inclusive in the money damages which he has heretofore assigned to him and a division of  
which among the parties as by them proposed to a future time but into two equal parts and  
assign one equal part to the Plaintiff John B. Williams the same having received to him in consequence  
first of the death of his infant child John Williams one third of his infant child Nathaniel  
Williams that they divide the remaining equal part into two other equal parts and assign one equal  
part to the complainant Nathaniel Bowers who claims the same by virtue of a bequest contained  
in the last will and Testament of the said Nathaniel Williams decedent and let them divide the  
remaining equal part equally between the defendants William Phillips and his wife Betsy and  
right of his said wife and the defendant Betsy Bey they being entitled to the same by  
virtue also of a bequest contained in the last will and Testament of the said Nathaniel Williams  
deceased. And it is further ordered that they or such of them as may act do make a report to  
the Court in order to a final decree.
