said John Brittle also enjoyed having regard to their value for use during the term of  
her natural life and for her dinner in the same and that they since the balance  
of the same give equal parts and upon one part to the complainant Hopkins and  
Leggy Brittle in right of her said wife and the remaining four parts between  
the aforesaid defendants, Alfred, Walter & Dennis and Marina Brittle and that they  
or either of them so may act as make a report to the court on account as herein  
directed

Rochelle his Testimons entreats unto and acknowledges a bond in the penalty of eight hundred
