three of them attested by the Surveyors of Southampton County, to divide the
lands and the bills mentioned hereinbefore by lot or division four hundred and
seventy acres of which Isaac Williams died seized in the said County
into four equal parts, having due regard as well to quality as quantity, and allot
one of the said parts to the complainant Elizabeth Parker, another of the said
parts to the complainant Rhoda Williams, another of the said parts to the defendants
Sops Parker and Lally his wife, and the remaining equal fourth part to the said
defendants Isiah Williams and Leth Williams, to be delivered over to the said
Isiah Davis, their guardian. It is further decreed and ordered and decreed by the
Court, that the said commissioners or any three of them do divide the following
lands to wit: James, Charles, Anthony, Peter, Joseph, Lucy, Amos, Benjamin, and

having due regard to the value of the said lands, and allot one of the said
parts to the complainant Elizabeth Parker, another of the said parts to the

said defendant Isiah Williams and Leth Williams, to be delivered over to the
