Vaughan and his further executors, trustees and successors, make a report of their actions and doings on this behalf to the court in order to a final decree.

The cause was this day heard upon the bill and the answer of the defendants
Athene Russ, and was argued by counsel, and it appears to the court that the claim made in
this cause against the said defendants Athene Adams and Betsy her wife and Harris
Russ had been duly published in the Petersburg Intelligencer, the bill of the complainants
is taken as complaint against them and the court after now affixing other and lesser
sums to the damages of the plaintiff, it is now ordered that the court direct the sheriff
that Reverend Russ, Mrs. Russ and Howell Russ or any two of them situated in the
County of Southampton, to have the lands belonging to the defendant John
Brantley and Joseph Russ and their friends acre of which Sally Russ died seized in the said
County into nine equal parts, having due regard as well to quality as quantity and will
one of the said parts to the complainant Reverend Russ, author of the bill unto the
plaintiff complainant John Russ, another of the said parts to the infant complainant
Howell Russ, another of the said parts to the infant complainant Mrs. Russ, another
of the said parts to the complainant Charity Russ, mother of the said John Russ to the
sisters and brothers Adams and Betsy his wife, another of the said parts to the left
Harris Russ, and another of the said parts to the defendant Athene Russ, and that
they sell the remaining equal ninth part at public sale (the sum not being more than the
sum of five hundred dollars) One a credit of Seven Months, giving at least Two months
previous public notice of the time and place of sale, and money the sum to be purchased
from whom they are to require bond with sufficient security payable to themselves, and
divide the proceeds of the said sale, when effected, equally between the infant
complainants, Norfolk Bay and - They, taking care to pay over the same to those
guardians or beneficiaries, if any they shall then have, or not to hold the same in
their hands, Subject to the further order of the court. It is further requested and
directed by the court that the said complainants, or any two of them, do also
sell at public auction, one or more of their respective goods, giving at least two months
