The Petitioners then and lawfully appointed Special Agents to the said Cause on the day docketed by the Court of the practice and report of the bond came on to be heard upon the bill of the complainant against the defendants and arguments of counsel thereupon it is decreed and ordered that John Dothier, Benjamin Hancock and Richard B. Kelle or any two of them, sometime Sals of the Lands where John Warren died seized and possessed before a Credit of Twelve Months, taking by Separate Bonds with appraisement from the purchaser or purchasers, and assigns one of the said lands to the complainant Peter B. Warren another of the said lands to Eliza Matilda Warren another of the said lands to the defendant Susanna Baker Warren, one other of the said lands to the defendant Hannah Emma Warren, one other of the said lands to the said Diana Morris Warren, and the remaining land to the said John Lawrence Warren, taking care to assign the same to the said Guarantors or Guarantors of the infant defendants if any they have, if not that the said Commissioners or Sals of them as may act return the same as their names Subject to the further order of the Court And that they make a report of their acting and doing in this behalf to the Court In order to a final Decree -

Now Decree is by the Court appointed Guarantors to James Dacus orphan of David Jacob Dacus that Whereupon the said David Dacus together with Jacob Dacus and John Parker his Security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two Thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs

And now Decree is by the Court appointed Guarantors to Polly Rowe and Henry Rowe orphans of Samuel Rowe deceased, Whereupon the said Robert together with Benjamin Nelson his Security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two Thousand dollars with condition according to law

On the Motion of Robert together with Guarantors to Polly and Henry Rowe orphans of Samuel Rowe deceased, and for reasons appearing to the Court It is decreed that he sell a negro boy named Abram the property of the said orphans for support furnished them by their said Guarantors when they were of 100 Twelve years of age bound as apprentices, that he first advertise the said boy at least two weeks before the day of Sale and require of the purchasers who purchase and fifty dollars in cash and give Twelve Months credit for the balance of the purchase money, requiring bond and Security, which balance he is to hold in hand, as Guarantors -
