the Signature of Bazan and the sale between William Lammens Lammens and wife Sally Lammens Books and Lammens his wife Benjamin Jones and his wife Betsey Jones and Nancy Jones of the one part, and Betsey Bell's of the other part are acknowledged by the said Betsey Jones his heirs here first jointly separated as the law directs and having been before previously the estate of the mortgages, are ordered to be recorded.

The Last will and Testament of Lucy Lammens deceased was proved by the oath of Peter Lammens and Pigea Lammens two of the mortgages thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of Peter Lammens one of the executors thereof named who made oath thereto and was with Henry B. Matthews and Nathaniel Lammens his Executors entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned as the said direct Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form of law and for the other executors named in the said will to qualify when he shall think proper.

Ordered that John Nicholas, Russell Nicholas, Rases Russell and John Myrick or any three of them being first sworn affirm as Justice of the peace appraisers and remove having the value of any old personal estate of Lucy Lammens and return the appraisement to the Court.

the Signature of Bazan and the Sale between Rice B. Pierce of the one part and John Phills of the other part was acknowledged by the said Rice B. Pierce and ordered to be recorded.

The persons appointed by a former order of this Court to make Sale of the Slaves which were assigned to Peter Blunt widow and relict of Williams Blunt and they say need their report in the words and figures following to wit: "Agreed to an order of Court at the January Court 1814 for the Return of a Sale of the said Slaves and negroes belonging to the estate of Williams Blunt and amounting to One thousand five hundred and twenty four dollars, twelve cents making the amount due to each legatee, two hundred and seventeen dollars and twenty three cents, with interest from the nineteenth day of November 1814. From and out our hands this 19th day of March 1814. Richard Blunt, Benjamin Jones & Benjamin Jones & Benjamin Jones" Whereupon it is ordered that the foregoing report be true from the Court and binding between the parties and that the debts be proportionally borne between them.
