Bayham and John Williamson or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace appraise in current money the value of any and personal estate of Mills Williamson deceased and return the appraisement to the clerk of the County unto whose hands the said deceaseds estate hath been committed. Tell the same on a writ of nine months. And also that Silas Summerville, Arthur Holliman, Samuel B. Bayham and John Williamson or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace appraise in current money the value of any and personal estate of James Phillips deceased and return the appraisement to the clerk of the County and that the Sheriff of the County make whose hands the said deceaseds estate hath been committed Tell the same on a writ of nine months.
