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Arthur Wemble who stands bound by a recognizance for his appearance here today to answer the Complaint of Mary Wemble against him for a breach of the peace offered accordingly. And the said Arthur Wemble the said Mary Wemble being fully heard by the Court. It is the opinion of the Court and accordingly ordered that the said Arthur Wemble give Security for his good behavior for the term of Twelve calendar months from this day that is to say himself in the sum of Two hundred dollars with two Sureties to be bound with him in the sum of one hundred dollars each and in default thereof the he be committed to Jail.

The Last will and Testament of Andrew Rewards deceased was proved by the oaths of John Fowler, Jeremiah L. Rewards and Rewards the witnesses thereto and is now to be recorded and on the motion of Isaac Rewards the executor named therein who made oath thereto and together with Wills Johnson and William Rewards his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two Thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probet thereof in due form.

Ordered that William Fowler, John Fowler, Tyler Rewards and James Rewards or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace approve in current money the value of any and personal Estate of Andrew Rewards deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

Depon Ferguson is by the Court appointed Executor to Nathan and Polly Rewards deceased of Joel Rewards deceased whereupon the said Depon Ferguson together with Solomon Barrett and William Ferguson his Sureties entered into due acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two Thousand Dollars with conditions according to Law.

Ordered that Spencer M. Jackson, Wills Brown and John Pratt being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace approve in current money the value of any and personal Estate of Henry Fulgham deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.
