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The Last will and Testament of Robert Williams deceased was proved by the oaths of Thomas Harrison and Elizabeth Nick son of the intestate Charles and ordered to be read. Elizabeth Williams the executrix and William Williams the executor named therein appeared in open Court to take upon themselves the burden of the execution thereof.

The Last will and Testament of John Luter deceased was proved by the oaths of Benjamin Wilson and Elizabeth Luter two of the intestate Charles and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of Jonathan Luter one of the executors named therein who made oath thereto and together with John Drakford and Benjamin Wilson his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form Liberty reserved for the other executor named in the said will to join the probat when he shall think fit.

Liberty Luter widow and relict of John Luter deceased by Certificate under her hand which was duly proved in open Court declaring that the will not take on except of the provisions made for her, in the last will and Testament of her deceased husband she only part thereof and renouncing all benefit which she has or might claim in or to the said will, which is ordered to be entered of Record.

The Last will and Testament of Jeremiah Whitney deceased was proved by the oaths of Obadiah Luter and Elizabeth Lane two of the intestate Charles and ordered to be read and on the motion of Joshua Whitney one of the executors named therein who made oath thereto and together with Benjamin Wilson and Jonathan Luter his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form.

Ordered that Pittway Shumway, Benjamin Wilson and Jonathan Luter being first Sworn before a Justice of the Peace appraise in current money the Slave if any and personal Estate of Jeremiah Whitney deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.
