"In obedience to an order of the honorable Court of Southampten bearing date July Court 1815 And to us directed on the Subscribers appointed prescribers to fix all the lands prescribers between Mottoway Swamp and Mottoway River and the old parish line, have proceeded and been to the prescribering of all the lands contained in the above boundaries with the exception of a line arising between Holt and Francis balant, said last foregoing us to prescriber the said line, and pray your honors to take into consideration the same Persons present before Holt, Newman Holt, Howell Brewer, Henry Johnson, John Earl, Joshua Fort, James Lott, Jeremiah Washington, Benjamin Hines, Joseph Boney, John Moor, Sinclair Snyder, Robinson Snyders, George Johnson, James Whitbread, Samuel Wallace, Richard Williams and Jeremiah Hephson making in all Three say your orders our hands this 16th day of March 1816 (Richard M. Williams and Nathan Pope. P. M.) Whereupon it is ordered that the Surveyors of this County with a Jury do lay out and prescriber the lands so in dispute at the charge of the party against whom the right to such bounds shall be determined, and return such Survey with the prescriberings thereon to the next Court after the said Survey shall be made —

The persons appointed at a former Court to view the repairs of Brocton Bridge this day make their report on the roads and figures following to wit:
"March 16th 1816 In obedience to the above order of the honorable Court of Southampten we whose names are herunto subscribed have on our night viewed the repair of Brocton Bridge and find the repairs sent to the said bridge to be agreeable to Contract Meller & Decker, Henry S. Burman commissioners — Which is ordered to be recorded —
