It is donc ordered and adjuged that the defendant be taken as confess'd and that she shall render against her self the sum of five pounds five shillings and six pence with interest thereon to the complainant after the rate of five per centum per annum from the 9th day of April 1808 till the time of payment and the costs.

On the motion of Ezra Turner who made oath and together with Michael Bufford and Samuel Bond his securities entered into and acknowledge a bond in penalty of one hundred and fifty dollars to the sum and certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Anthony Miller deceased and due form.

Orders that John Drury, Joseph Nick, Benjamin Brathew and Lawrence Taylor or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace appear in present money the Slave if any are personal estate of Anthony Miller deceased and return the appraisement to the court.

On the motion of Matthew Parker who made oath and together with Nathaniel Tolson and Alfred Simmons his securities entered into and acknowledge a bond in penalty of five thousand dollars to the sum and certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Matthew Parker deceased in due form.

Orders that Mansfield Freeman, Richard R. Clements, Robert Nicholson and Benjamin Moore or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace do appraise no plainer money the Slave if any are personal estate of Melinda Parker deceased and return the appraisement to the court.
