On Indenture of bargain and Sale between William Johnson and Peter his wife of the County of Philadelphia in the State of Georgia of the one part and Benjamin Blunt of the County of the other part with a full and plenary indenture of Benjamin Blunt as witness of the said County of Philadelphia, testifying the acknowledgment of the said Johnson and the acknowledgment of the party to the instrument of the said Peter, & with the subscriber Isaac Collier Clerk of the said County of Philadelphia minor his hand and Seal of the office testifying that the above mentioned Company was, now admitted to the said District of the said County, and that Benjamin Johnson has an estate proprietory of that County, also with a certificate of Henry Brasham and George of the Superior Court of Georgia, testifying that Isaac Collier was Clerk of the said Superior Court of the aforesaid County, and this day presented my bond for record, and Stevenson was ordered to be recorded.

James Lee who was Summoned to the Court to qualify as an overseer of the poor, of this County in the upper Extent of Saint Luke Parish, the day appeared, and upon his motion not to qualify and for sufficient reason gave to the Court His Oaths that he was excused, and it is also ordered that Benjamin Blunt (of Benjamin) be Summoned to the next Court to qualify as such in the room of the said James Lee.

On the motion of Thomas Butter who mess each, and together with Thomas Jones and Peter Turnerville his Neighbors entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Ten Thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted the said Thomas Butter for obtaining Letter of administration Debts now on the said of Edward Dawson deceased, with his small debts for funeral and reasonable charges due from —

Richmond Dillard is appointed Surveyor of the road from South quay Bridge to the falls of the road near Jeffs Park, and for the parts of the road near the River to be so County born in the room of Captain Lyon, who hath removed. And it is ordered that the male labourers of the said place who usually worketh therein do attend and assist the said Surveyor in repairing the said road when required.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County make wherein the estate of Revew Phillips deceased hath been committed, pay to John Wiggard the sum of Fifty Dollars per Annum thereon to be computed after the rate of the per centum per annum from the first day of January 1808 till paid, less his two bonds both, and account with the Court.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County unto whom bears the Estate of Willi Williamson deceased hath been committed pay to Rachell Williamson in the sum of Twenty Two dollars and Sixty Five cents Also Fifty Two bonds both, and account with the Court.

On Indenture of bargain and Sale between Jacob Dawson of the one part and Jeffs Parker of the other part, was acknowledged in open Court by the said Jacob Dawson and ordered to be recorded.
