Whereupon the said Robert Mellers together with William Mellers and Samuel Bond his Executors entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four thousand Dollars, with condition according to law

Whereupon the said John Smith together with John Bailey and Benjamin James his Executors entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand Dollars with condition according to law
