Come that the sum above set out Harry Mallon and another doth pay the same according to law.

On Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Joseph Marshall deceased was the same returned and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Miller Mallon he is appointed Guardian to Seth R. and Amy Grigsby and their nephew of James Poore deceased. Whereupon the said Miller Mallon together with Robert Mallon and James Poore his Committee entered into an acknowledgment a bond in the penalty of three thousand Dollars, with Condition according to law.

James Treguant Esqur the day present to the Court a Commission appointing him Colonel of the 15 Regiment Virginia Militia. now the 1st of October subscriber of this Commission Major George Brittle begins his term or chief magistrate of this Commissionality. Whereupon the said James Treguant took the same and recd. prescribed by law.

No. 1 Aponce bond for the full amount of property then upon the shelves of a man of

parishes set out of this Court by the Pet against the said Charles Story and John Revelle Secuity for his appearance.

This day Came the Parties by their attorneys and it appearing to the Satisfaction of the Court by the affidavit of Joseph Blanton Deputy of Hardy County Sheriff taken in open Court that the Defendants have had legal notice of this action, say one hundred days but came not. Wherefore His Excellency by the Court that the Defendants may have execution against the Defendants for eighty three dollars and four cents the penalty of the said bond and he doth by him in this behalf require and the said Defendants are ready to pay at the Court the sum aforesaid to be discharged by the payment of forty one Dollars and fifty two cents with interest thereon calculated after the rate of six per centum per annum from the second day of October 1816 until the time of payment by the 1st.

On the motion of Robert Mallon he is appointed Guardian to Elizabeth Mallon wife of Miller Mallon deceased. Whereupon the Robert Mallon together with Miller Mallon and Samuel Poore his Committee entered into an acknowledgment a bond in the penalty of four thousand Dollars, with Condition according to law.

On the motion of Jane Brittle she is appointed Guardian to Alpheus & Mallie John & Maria Brittle children of John Brittle deceased. Whereupon the said Jane Brittle together with Jepo Badley and Benjamin Fance her Committee entered into an acknowledgment a bond in the penalty of five thousand Dollars with Condition according to law.
