On the motion of James Rochelle Clerk of the Court (Robin Middleton) is

and the oath of office

On the motion of Harrison J. Griffin who made oath and together with James
and Elizabeth Griffin his Executive interest into and acknowledged a bond in the County
of 1000 Dollars to the effect that the said David Griffiths is granted him
for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Abraham Vette deceased
in due form

Ordered that Benjamin Braashear, Anthony Mills, William Dams and Thomas
Whipple or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace of the
County, do appraise and invent the same of any and several estate of Abraham
Vette deceased and return the appraisement to the Court
