Negro and child and Molly to Lucretia Whitehead Valuation £5.00 and revenue from Adolphus Whitehead £20. James Negret £10.00 Mollie, Thomas Steddy Davis deceased Wherupon Her Honour this orders that the foregoing report and division be held firm & binding between the parties and that the costs be proportionally borne between them."
