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On the motion of Misha Terry who made oath and together with Arthur a Kern and William Boone his Secutaries entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand Dollars conditioned as the Law directs, but fails to grant him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of James Williams deceased in due form

Ordered that Henry Cotton, Abner Cotton, Jones, Richard Kimes and James Britt or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace of this County do appraise the current money, the value of any and personal estate of James Williams deceased, and return the appraisement to the Court

On the motion of John Koon who made oath and together with Anna Hephew and Augustus Pope his Secutaries entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand Dollars conditioned as the Law directs, but fails to grant him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Elizabeth Williams deceased in due form

Ordered that Anna Hephew, William Boone and Nathan Pope being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace of this County do appraise the current money, the value of any and personal estate of Elizabeth Williams deceased and return the appraisement to the Court

An account current of the estate of Morry Kirby deceased was this day returned and ordered to be recorded

Mrs Boone appointed by a former Deeree of the Court to make a division of the Slave of John Whitehead dec'd which remained at the death of his most numerous Whitehead. This day make their report in the words and figures following to wit: "In Obedience to an order of the County Court of Southhampton, to us directed bearing date December Court 1844 We have proceeded to divide the Slave of John Whitehead deceased which remained at the death of his widow Merriam Whitehead as follows, negro man George to Archer Miss Whitehead, Valuation \$405 and pay Martha & John Bell \$5 negro man Jim to Balthrop, Pond in right of his wife Harriet Whitehead Valuation \$400, two boys, John & Lewis and Ansell to Adolphus Whitehead Valuation \$440 and pay Martha and John, Will \$20 and Lucinda Whitehead \$20 Phillis and child Rudow, to Martha and John Bell Valuation \$370 and receive from Archer Miss Whitehead \$6 and from Adolphus Whitehead \$20, Venus and child and Molly to Lucinda Whitehead Valuation \$550 and receive from Adolphus Whitehead \$20 James Magget, William Mearns, Thomas Hadley Sumo Lewis dec'd" Whereupon the Court has ordered that the foregoing report and division be held firm, full and binding between the Parties and that the Costs be proportionally borne between them

An account current of the estate of Martha Willford deceased was this day returned and ordered to be recorded

William Brown this day produced to the Court the Sheriff's receipt for the amount of Ten pounds by law on hawks and Poles trading in goods, wares and manufactures of foreign growth and manufacture, Harbison It is ordered that the said William Brown, permitting to trade as a hawker and Poles in goods, wares and manufactures of foreign growth and manufacture within the first day of May next ensuing
