Smith, and that the said Complainers, or Trustees there, as act, in making the allotments of acres and acres, have paid regard to the quality of the said Several tracts or parcels of Land, and that they make the said allotment of acres and acres, and the said four hundred and four Acres of Land, subject to the power to take therein of a certain Freehold, and that each allotment of acres and acres in the said Last mentioned tract or parcel of Land, subject to the power to take therein, of a certain Chappin Kinsay, and make a report of their acting and doing in this behalf to the Court in or to a final Decree.
