 and as the said Deborah Whitney had willed one part of his lands by will
 to John Whitney Jun^r as all the lands is now in the possession of John
 and David Whitney, we have signed Dorothy Whitney's order to her in all the
 said lands bearing regard to quality as well as quantity by proper metes and bounds to
 her for life. Given under our hands this 7th day of July 1776, William Byrd
 Jonathan Suter, Benjamin Mills, Pelham Johnson" (Whompon It is deemed
 and ordered that the foregoing report be held firm stable and binding between the
 Parties and that the Cols be proportionally be divided between them

On the motion of Elizabeth Corry she made oath and together with George Whitson
 and Charles Holt her Executors entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty
 of Two Thousand Dollars to be returned as the Law direct Certificate is granted her
 for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Sarah Corry deceased
 in due form

Ones that Isaac Bousell, Rowell Bep. Owen Myrick and Myatt Barham among
 else of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace of this County, do
 appear in barrill return the Law if any and personal estate of Rowell Bousell
 deceased and return the appraisement to the Court

On the motion of Rowell Nicholson he is appointed Guardian to John Nicholson
 orphan of Charles B. Nicholson deceased. Nicholson do and Rowell Nicholson together
 with Henry Mason: C^t State - Nicholson his executors entered into and
 acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four thousand Dollars with Rowell
 according to Law
