

Ordered that Amos Harris, William Sanders and others forth or any two of them do examine the said letter the account of the same in to them on the State of said Harris and make a report thereof to the Court.

About said Darnall, Benjamin Darnall, Benjamin M. Schuster and James Darnall Justice
Ordered that the hands belonging to Thomas Gray which formerly belonged to James Gray, do work on the road whereof William Hastings is Surveyor, in future also the hands belonging to Daniel Webb work on the said road, and keep the same in repair according to law.

About James Jones, Present Benjamin Darnall, Just. Justice
Now the Petition of Benjamin Griffin, setting forth that he wishes a road to be opened from the Perry Road road at either Brown line to the black water road near black creek meeting route. It is ordered that William Rogers, James Jones and Charles Griffin or any two of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose, do view the lands through which the said road is proposed to be opened, and report to the next Court, the same and inconvenience that will result as well to the public as individuals, if the said road shall be opened as proposed.

About Benjamin Darnall, Present James Jones Just. Justice
Ordered that Thomas Raley, Justice William and Richard O'Connell or any two of them do let the rebuilding of the once Crab Bridge formerly called Smith bridge to the Court under taking taking bond with approved security for the due and faithful performance of the same, and that they or such as act, make a report thereof to the Court.

Present Benjamin Darnall, Just. Justice

Ordered the State of John Mcnemond because he committed to the house of the Sheriff of the County and that he administer before now thereon, according to law, and that he return an account thereof to the Court.

A Report of the disputed line between Logan hill and Frances Calvert, was this day returned, but is in the mode and figures following to wit

hill that the said line was in dispute was the same that was run by James Jones
the County Surveyor, when the tract of five acres was laid off which was sold at
the sale of the estate of Samuel Calvert deceased and brought by him the said hill, being
attested by the said County Surveyor, so say that the said line is as follows to wit
beginning at a black gum in a branch of Logan hill thence S 77° 33' E 100 pds to a
small black gum a corner of Frances Calvert and Logan hill thence S 12° 20' E 100 pds
to a red oak a corner of the said hill and Frances Calvert which said line was fully
appealed by having reference to the 1814 survey and the report, given under our hands
and sets the day and year above written, Henry Briggs, James Jones, John
Richard & Williams, John Mason, Matthew Darnall, Abel Wallcut, Lewis
P. Hart, Joseph Rogers, John Ketchum, John Row and John Ketchum
