This day came the Parties by their attorneys and the defendant relinquishing his former plea acknowledging the Plaintiff's action. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recovers against the defendant Twenty Pounds Sterling. Together the debt in the declaration mentioned and the costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended are the case Defendant in Money. But the Judgment is to be dischargeable by the Payment of Two Pounds Eight Shillings with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of Six per Centum per annum from the first day of October 1806 until the time of payment and the costs. Subject to the following Costs to Mr. Tracy by Plaintiff. Paid the Twentieth day of June 1806 one dollar Paid October twentieth 1807. Three dollars and twenty five shillings Paid April last 1813. and twenty five pounds Paid
